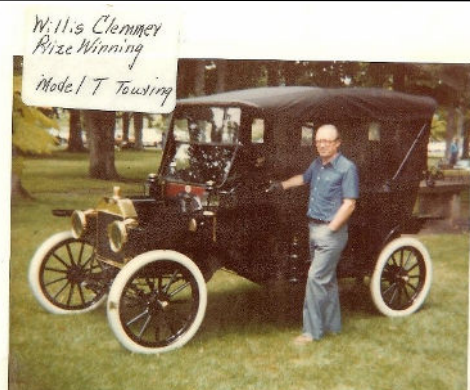

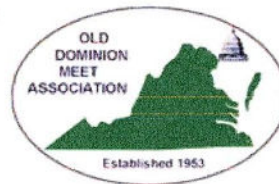

# 72nd Annual ODMA MEET

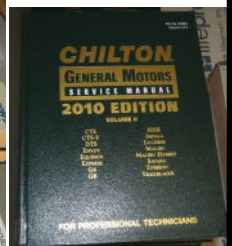
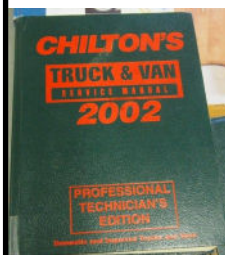
