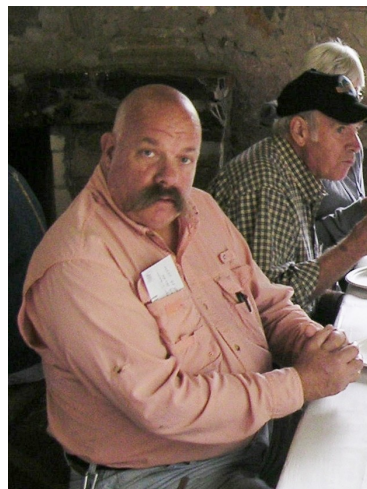
Please do not forget to pay your National and Region dues which are both now due.

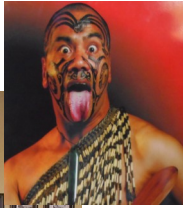

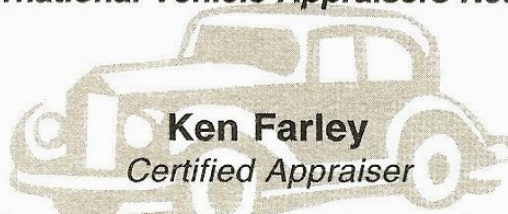

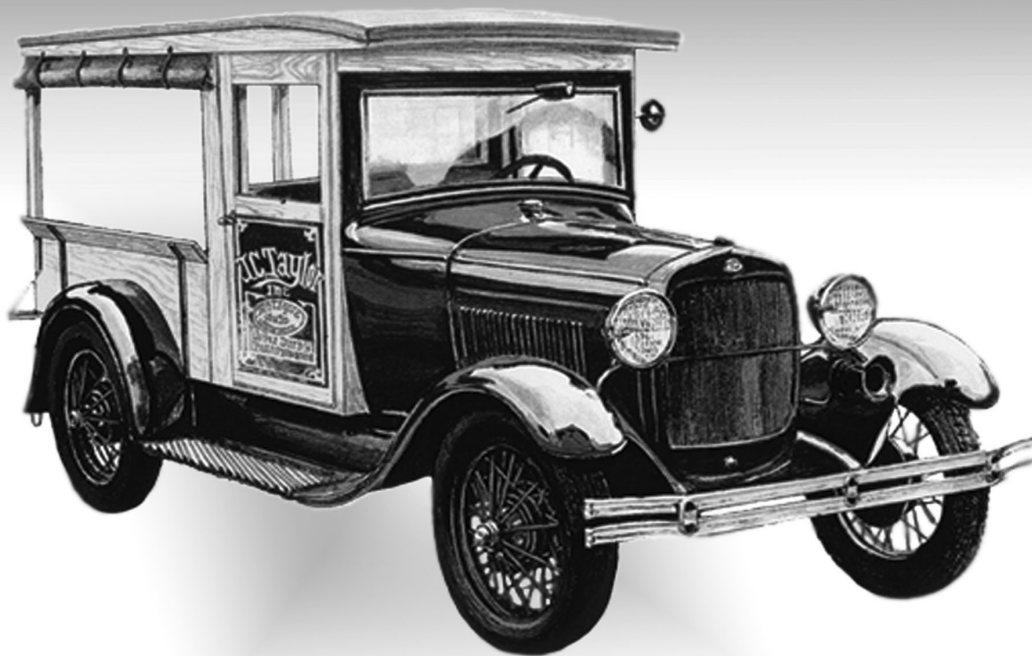
