Greetings Waynesboro-Staunton Region Members,

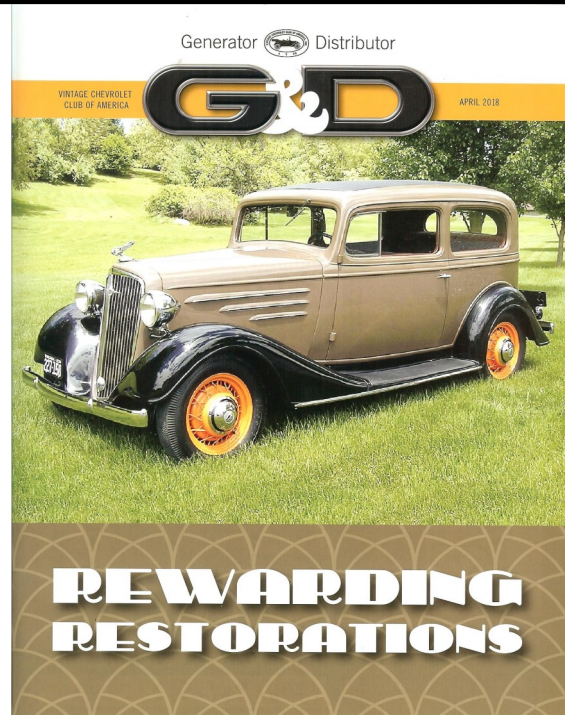

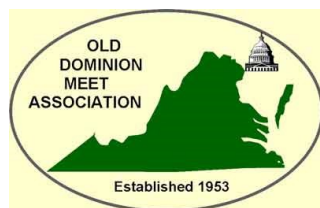
